PAINTED SURFACES

- Vehicle to be washed with soap and water prior to installation.
- Vinyl can be applied to automotive painted surfaces by first using Isopropyl alcohol or other mild solvent cleaner to remove wax and other road debris.

POLYETHYLENE (PLASTIC) SURFACES

- Wipe the entire surface with Isopropyl alcohol or other mild solvent.
- If your plastic surface has a plastic protective covering, remove and wait 24-48 hours for resins to evaporate and dissipate. This process must be observed or you may risk the chance of bubbles forming in your vinyl later.



Vehicle graphics should not be applied to a newly painted vehicle. Allow at least 60 days for fresh paint to cure.



Do not apply graphics to any vehicle with visibly damaged paint or clear coat.

Checklist

- Is the vehicle surface in good condition?
- Has the vehicle been thoroughly washed and dried?
- Has it been a minimum of 60 days since the vehicle was painted?
- Have plastic surfaces had ample time to outgas?
